

CHAIN O'LAKES SPORTSMAN'S CLUB RULES

11/11/2010

1. **Membership includes you, your spouse, children under 18 living in your household, and dependent children over 18 attending college or vocational school.**
2. **Members may access the COLSC property and use the pistol and rifle ranges at any time. Eye and ear protection is required.**
3. **Members may bring a guest twice for use of rifle and pistol facilities. After that, they must join.**
4. **Guests pay the non-member rate for skeet, trap, five stand, Cowboy Action Shooting, and USPSA Action Pistol.**
5. **Please keep the gate closed and locked while you are at the club when the club is not open to the public.**
6. **Please do not allow children to climb the sand berms in the CAS-USPSA –pistol areas. This reduces the height of the berms, making them less safe and in need of repair.**
7. **When a Cowboy Action Shoot or a USPSA Shoot is in progress, the pistol bay closest to the storage trailer may be used, but not the other stages set up for the shoot.**
8. **Please do not re-arrange, or shoot at, the USPSA and CAS targets after they have been setup and painted for an upcoming shooting event.**
9. **Do not use jacketed or high-powered ammunition on the steel targets. Cast lead ammo only on these targets.**
10. **Rifle shooters may not use the 200-yard range unless approved by a Range Safety Officer. No caliber below .204 Ruger on the 200-yard range.**
11. **Range Safety Officers to contact for 200-yard range approval: Al Moran @ 231-492-5277, Bob Bergmann @ 231- 258-5303, Bill Clark @ 888-875-5769, or Rich Collins @ 231-676-7791.**
12. **The 200-yard range is not to be used when a USPSA shoot is in progress.**
13. **Please remove your paper targets from the range when you are done shooting and clean up your empty brass.**
14. **During rifle sight-in days, members do not pay the per-gun sight in fee.**
15. **Members may not hunt on COLSC property, only Founders.**
16. **Skeet and trap are available only on designated shooting days, under supervision of a member of the Clays Committee, unless prior permission is obtained. Pick up all spent shotgun shells from shotgun ranges.**
17. **USE COMMON SENSE. OBSERVE ALL SAFETY PROCEDURES IN HANDLING FIREARMS. CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF, ENJOY THE PREMISES, AND GET INVOLVED.**
18. **USE / POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL / DRUGS PROHIBITED.**
